Title

- The title should provide a concise, thorough statement of the topic.
- Select key words from your research question
- Identify succinctly the research method to be used
- Reflect the location of your study

Abstract

- Your abstract should provide a concise, coherent summary (300 words) of your proposed study
- What the study is about
- The aim or purpose of the study
- How it is to be carried out (design, including data collection and analysis)
- The significance of the outcomes

Timelines

The time line for your EdD project starts with your proposal in July 2008 and includes:

- your proposal defence in October 2008,
- a plan for completion of your thesis, including submission of draft chapters.

This timeline will be revised in consultation with your supervisor before you submit your final draft

Budget

In constructing your budget list expenses by category, for instance:

- Travel
- Equipment rental and purchase
- Materials and supplies
- Communications
- Indirect cost

You may already own (or have access to) some of the items you will need, so you may not have to purchase them.

Ethical Statement

- In addition to the application form for Human Rights and Ethics approval:
- include a brief statement that identifies any ethical concerns related to your study
- explain how you will overcome them
- include a statement to the effect that your study will conform to all ethical requirements of UWA.

References

- Use an approved Style Manual (APAS) and apply it consistently.
- Every text referred to in your proposal must be fully detailed in your List of References.
- No others should be included (i.e. select from your main list of references only those cited in your proposal).
- All references should appear in the same format in your text and in the List of References.
